

Declaration according to regulation (EU) 2019/1021 (POP)

The ADMEDES Group (hereinafter referred to as ADMEDES) declares that there are no persistent organic pollutants (POPs) in the components/parts of medical devices produced for our customers. To our best knowledge, the components/parts are in compliance with the POPs Regulation and do not contain substances subject to prohibitions listed in Annex I to Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 and amended 2020/784/EU.

Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 deals with the protection of the human health and the environment against these substances by a preferably early elimination of production or accordingly by the limitation to a minimum regarding manufacturing, placing on the market and usage of these substances. Furthermore, the regulation defines provisions about waste which consist of these substances, in which these substances are contained, or which are contaminated by these substances.

The parts we deliver to our customers are cleaned metal components. We do not use POP's neither in the raw material nor in our manufacturing process chain.
